

## Healthgrades Hospital Quality Clinical Excellence Report 2013: Announcing the Top 5% Hospitals in the U.S. for 2013

We are pleased to announce the 262 Distinguished Hospital Award for Clinical Excellence™ recipients for 2013. This recognition places these hospitals in the top 5% of hospitals in the nation.

During the 2013 study period (2009-2011), 262 hospitals showed superior performance in caring for patients in the Medicare population, as measured by objective clinical outcomes (risk-adjusted mortality and in-hospital complications) across at least 19 of 27 of the most common inpatient conditions and procedures. These hospitals are recognized as Healthgrades 2013 Distinguished Hospital Award for Clinical Excellence recipients (see *Tables 2 and 3*).

These 262 hospitals stand out among the rest for overall clinical excellence across a broad spectrum of care. While many hospitals have specific areas of expertise and high-quality outcomes in certain areas, these hospitals exhibit comprehensive high-quality care across clinical specialties.

### All Hospitals Are Not Created Equal: Hospital Choice Matters

As shown in the *American Hospital Quality Outcomes 2013: Healthgrades Report to the Nation*, we've seen considerable improvement in hospital quality over time. However, quality disparities among hospitals persist, and hospital quality can vary significantly even within local service areas.

Hospital choice can strongly influence patients' odds of experiencing complications or emerging from their procedure alive and well. Study findings showed that there is wide variation in hospital quality across conditions and procedures: specific hospitals perform better than others in specific conditions and procedures.

You should consider objective measures of hospital performance (risk-adjusted mortality and complication rates) for specific conditions and procedures when selecting both your physician and the hospital where your physician provides care.

### Hospitals Have Opportunity to Showcase Quality Performance

Today, consumers have unprecedented opportunities to research and review information about hospital performance on specific conditions and procedures. Millions of consumers visit Healthgrades.com every month to compare the quality of hospitals side-by-side, and make informed decisions on where to obtain care.

Both the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act provide mandates to improve our current healthcare system and outcomes, increase access to health coverage, and provide tools for patients to make informed choices when seeking care.

With this heightened attention on healthcare outcomes, it has become even more critical for hospitals to communicate their commitment to providing outstanding patient care and to show their continued efforts to improve clinical outcomes.

Distinguished Hospital Award for Clinical Excellence recipients have a unique opportunity to leverage this elite distinction and to differentiate themselves as one of the nation's top hospitals—demonstrating that they provide overall better than expected performance in clinical outcomes and high-quality care across clinical specialties. This information is of paramount importance to consumers making a decision—an informed decision—about where to obtain healthcare.



### Healthgrades Distinguished Hospitals for Clinical Excellence

From 2009 through 2011, Healthgrades Distinguished Hospitals for Clinical Excellence as a group had an overall:

across 18 procedures and conditions where in-hospital mortality was the clinical outcome, compared to all other hospitals.

From 2009 through 2011, if all other hospitals performed at the level of Distinguished Hospitals for Clinical Excellence:

### CLINICAL EXCELLENCE MATTERS

- As we show in the *American Hospital Quality Outcomes 2013: Healthgrades Report to the Nation*, released in October, there are significant variations in hospital quality across conditions and procedures.
- Distinguished Hospital Award for Clinical Excellence recipients are unique because they exhibit high-quality care across clinical specialties.
- With heightened attention on healthcare outcomes, it has become even more critical for hospitals to provide outstanding patient care and to show their continued efforts to better than expected clinical outcomes for their patients.
- All hospitals are *not* created equal. Selecting the right physician or hospital can mean the difference between having a complication-free surgery or can even be a matter of life or death.

## How Healthgrades Determined the 2013 Distinguished Hospital Award for Clinical Excellence Recipients

To be eligible for the Healthgrades Distinguished Hospital Award for Clinical Excellence, a hospital had to have been evaluated for its performance in at least 19 of the 27 Healthgrades procedures and conditions, which are based on Medicare inpatient data from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services Medicare Provider Analysis and Review (MedPAR) database.

After creating a list of eligible hospitals that met these criteria, Healthgrades took the following steps to identify Distinguished Hospital Award for Clinical Excellence recipients:

1. Calculated the average star rating and average z-score for each hospital by averaging all of their MedPAR-based star ratings and corresponding z-scores.
2. Ranked hospitals in descending order by their average star rating, with ties broken by average z-score.
3. Selected the top 262 hospitals on the list (which represents the top 5% of all hospitals in the nation evaluated by Healthgrades).
4. Designated these 262 hospitals receive the 2013 Distinguished Hospital Award for Clinical Excellence.

Hospital quality performance measures used for this award are risk-adjusted mortality rates and in-hospital complication rates across 27 of the most common conditions and procedures based on MedPAR data (see Table 1).

## How Healthgrades Measures Hospital Performance

Every year, Healthgrades analyzes three years of Medicare Provider Analysis and Review (MedPAR) data to produce a detailed report on mortality and complication rates in America's hospitals. Healthgrades findings empower consumers to evaluate and compare hospital performance. Healthgrades analyzed approximately 40 million Medicare-patient records for nearly 4,500 short-term, acute care hospitals nationwide, assessing hospital performance for 28 common conditions and procedures.<sup>1</sup>

The Healthgrades methodology uses multivariate logistic regression to adjust for patient demographic and clinical risk factors that influence patient outcomes in significant and systematic ways. Risk factors may include age, gender, specific procedure performed, and comorbid conditions, such as high blood pressure and diabetes. Individual risk models are constructed and tailored for each of the conditions or procedures relative to each specific outcome.

Model outcomes reflect clinical-based measures of patient disposition during and after care, and include in-hospital complications, or in-hospital mortality, 30-day and 180-day post-admission mortality. Healthgrades groups hospital quality performance into three categories:

- **5-Stars** reflect hospital performance that is statistically better than expected.
- **3-Stars** reflect hospital performance that is not statistically different than expected.
- **1-Star** reflects hospital performance that is statistically worse than expected.

Healthgrades recognizes hospitals for quality achievements by cohort-specific performance, specialty area performance, and overall best performance in these categories. <sup>1</sup> To identify Distinguished Hospital Award in Clinical Excellence recipients, Healthgrades uses 27 conditions and procedures, which are based on MedPAR data. The remaining procedure, to total 28 conditions and procedures, is Appendectomy, which is based on all-payer data from those states which make their data available to Healthgrades.
